ST 122 THEOLOGY I SYLLABUS

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I. Course Description

This course is a study of the Biblical principles related to Christian growth, and the victorious Christian life (includes discussions related to the Gospel, and what is the Gospel).

The role of the Holy Spirit in the believer's life is also set forth.

This course also includes a technical study of the doctrine of the Holy Spirit in His person and work (the details of "pneumatology").

II. Course Objective

- A. That the student's life would be changed as they practice the principles necessary to growth in the Christian life.**
- B. That the student will be able to show with Scriptural support the deity and personality of the Holy Spirit.**
- C. The student will be able to distinguish between the concepts related to the ministry of the Holy Spirit (baptism, indwelling, and filling) and to discuss them intelligently.**
- D. The student will be able to explain their position on the tongues issue.**
- E. The student will be able to clearly delineate what the terms of the Gospel are (the content, the offer and the conditions).**
- F. The student will understand the teaching on Spiritual Gifts and will begin to discover their gifts.**

IV. Course Requirements
